Directions:

From Dundee (A90)

Take the road signposted Perth/ Scone (A85)

From the Scone Road (A85)

Follow signs for Edinburgh (not Dundee)

From the South (M90)

Take the slip road for Junction 11

Go part way round the roundabout, ignore the Walnut Grove left-hand turn and take the next left-hand turn (on the bend just before you go under the Friarton Bridge). It is a rough lane with part of a cottage visible from the road. Go down the lane, over the railway bridge and turn **sharp** right. Follow the track under the bridge to the bothy/ parking area.
