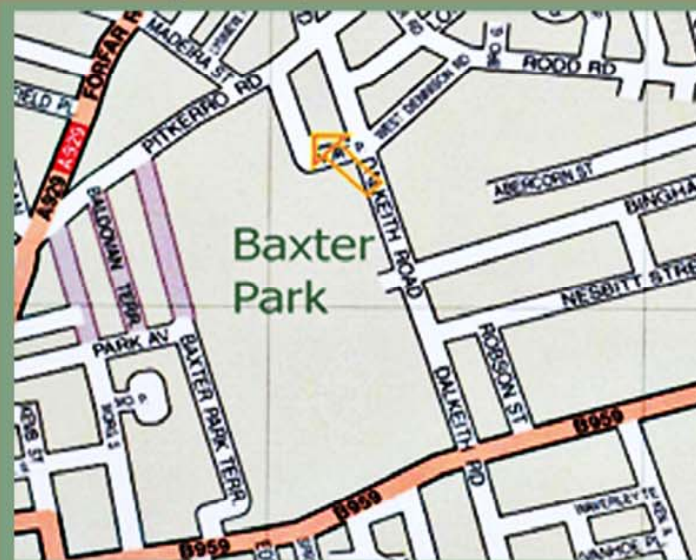


Further Details:
