



1708 – a world first?





The actual foundation date was 22nd January 1874

The 150th anniversary year began in January 2024 with a lecture on James Durham by Rob Duck

Durham was an early member and geologist

Lectured to DNS over 20 times between 1875 and 1902

Early recorded outing in 1875 to Norman's Law in north Fife
